

## Zechariah 5: Flying In and Flying Out

### 1. What in the world is this? It's God's judgment on sinners, sin, and the system that perpetrates it all, Zechariah 5.

- ✓ What's flying in is a gigantic scroll, 30x15 feet in size. It represents God's Word, **Jeremiah 23:29, and Hebrews 4:12**. But if God's Word is not allowed to fix you, it will destroy you, **Deuteronomy 30:15**. The Word of God is either a blessing or a curse; the decision is yours. It flies in like an airplane banner, but it works like a bulldozer, **verse 4c**. It is a symbol of God, the thoroughness of God's Word to accomplish what it says.
  - ✓ Added tidbits to paint a perfectly clear picture:
    - 1) Its size is 20x10 cubits was the same size as the Holy Place in the Tabernacle.
    - 2) Its construction, written on both sides in the same way that the entire Ten Commandments were. These two commandments represented the whole, **Matthew 26:37-38**.

### 2. The purging of sin and sinners is the flight in, and the flight out is the system that promotes it all.

- ✓ The second half of the vision begins with an ephah, the largest unit of dry measure roughly equivalent to a bushel. The measure of sin in Israel was large and full, and God was going to remove it from them, **Jeremiah 31:34, Romans 4:7-8**.

**You want this flying out because the Lord's Judgement will fly in eventually.**
