Acts of Jesus, Lesson 5: You Will Receive Power, Part 2 notes

- Last time we started a study of the Holy Spirit and His coming on the day of Pentecost
- <u>Since a good definition of the Church is</u>: Those people in whom God dwells through His Holy Spirit
- This is a subject we cannot just touch on because it is central to who we are.
- 1. Let me begin by saying that it is not easy being the Holy Spirit: I Cor. 2:14
- He has a history of being: Resisted (v. 14a), Ridiculed (v. 14b), Misunderstood (v. 14c)
- With this as His record I think it will be easy to understand why we tend know the least about the Person_and work of the Holy Spirit.
- Probably the most important question is: "who is the Spirit": He is God
- Of course, there are many verses which demonstrate that God and the Spirit of God are synonymous. Ps. 139:7
- <u>Common sense would say</u> that the spirit of something is the essence of it, likewise the Spirit of God is the very essence of God Himself.
- <u>If anyone has a question as to His equality with God</u> and His place in the Trinity, let them keep this verse in mind: <u>Mt. 12:31-32</u>
- Why is blasphemy against the Holy Spirit the unforgivable sin? Simple put: Because it puts a person outside God's forgiveness (notice: "will not forgive" not "cannot forgive")
- A Believer cannot commit this sin. Why? You'll see!!
 - 1. The Spirit convicts of sin and wrongdoing John 16:7-11
 - 2. The Spirit births us into God's family Titus 3:5, John 3:5
 - 3. The Spirit guides us into all truth John 16:13
 - 4. The Spirit transforms us. II Cor. 3:18
 - 5. The Spirit seals us. Eph. 1:13-14
 - 6. The Spirit lives in us. Rom. 8:9
- It should be clear that to resist Him and blaspheme Him is the unpardonable sin:
- A person who does such: -Does not receive conviction about sin
 - Does not <u>receive birth</u> into God's family
 - <u>Is not guided</u> into all truth
 - Is <u>not transformed</u>
 - Is not sealed
 - Does not have the <u>Spirit living in them</u>.
- <u>The Spirit certainly does reside</u> in all believers. <u>But He most certainly does not preside</u> **over** all believers.
- The Spirit's **presence** is standard, but His **filling** is optional.
- Can you survive without it?---Sure, but not abundantly!!
