- <u>We saw last time a guy who had a pretty good racket going on</u> outside the east gate of the Temple, but even the best racket leaves you lame compared to a touch from God Himself. <u>Acts 3:1-10</u>
 - <u>We started last time answer the question</u>: Where does God's power flow? And we came up with a couple of answers
 - 1. God's power flows where He is.
 - Where is God today? With us!!
 - We often suffer from the Mary and Martha complex of believing on Him in the past and the future but having a hard time
 - believing Him for today.
 - <u>He's with us today and every day</u> everywhere we go
 - 2. <u>The second answer to our question= God's power flows where there is</u> <u>expectancy</u>
 - Expect Him to be God
 - <u>Hudson Taylor's</u> life motto: "Attempt great things for God, Expect Great things from God!"
 - <u>Often get so little from God</u> because we expect so little of Him.

We have one more answer left to our question of where does God's power flow: God's power flows where He will receive the glory.
