## **Acts of Jesus, Lesson 14: Open-Eyed Christians**

## 1. We are going to be taking a look at a guy named Barnabas.

- I want to give you the recipe for a sour Christian experience and church life. Come to church for yourself, think only of yourself, gather spiritual things solely to expend on yourself.
- <u>The Dead Sea is dead because it only</u> takes, and never gives---Dead Sea Christian is no different
- We've got to be about giving ourselves away to keep the living water flowing in us.
- If you'll keep your eyes opened to people and their needs, you'll be amazed at the ministries you'll find to be involved in.

## 2. What got the Joseph the name Barnabas was the fact that he constantly had his eyes and his hands open to help those in need.

- We are first introduced to him in the minutes of the early church in Jerusalem. Acts 4:32-37
- He had his eyes open!
- The next place we see Barnabas in Scripture, we again see him with his eyes open.
- <u>In Chapter 9 of Acts we read of the incredible conversion</u> of Saul of Tarsus on the road to Damascus.
- <u>Saul was of course a horrible persecutor</u> of believers prior to his conversion and believers were quite reluctant to let him enter their ranks. <u>Acts 9:26</u>
- <u>But Barnabas instead of seeing a murderer he saw through what caused fear and skepticism in others and saw someone who needed mercy and a friend. Acts 9:27-28</u>
- Who believed in you when others would have written you off?
- Got to keep your eyes open!
- <u>The third place we come across Barnabas in Acts</u> he again demonstrates the need for this Opened-eyed ministry.
- <u>He found God moving in great ways in Antioch and applied himself</u> there so that the ministry there flourished: <u>Acts 11:23-24</u>
- But then he does something not many preachers would do Acts 11:25-26.
- God is blessing his ministry and with his eyes open he immediately says, "who can I share this blessing with?"
- When things are going well for us we need to immediately think of others we can share our success with.
- Successful in ministry? Who can you mentor?
- <u>Walked along with the Lord?</u> Who can you encourage to hang in there and give away your success to?
- <u>Have a happy marriage and family find another</u> you can encourage share your success with. <u>A final place we find Barnabas he gives</u> us yet another lesson about keeping our eyes open:

## Acts 15:37-39

- <u>It goes without saying that we need to forgive people who wrong us</u>, but often times we need to give them not just forgiveness but second chance.
- How do we treat those who fail? Who fall into sin?
- <u>Do we stand by them and restore them</u>, or do we shoot our wounded?
- <u>John Mark turned out to be the writer of the gospel of Mark</u> and even Paul later decided that Barnabas was right about Mark: **II Timothy 4:11**
