Acts of Jesus, Lesson 23: A Good Name

What's in a name? Our series in the book of Acts and considering the first place where followers of Jesus were called Christians.

1. Acts 11:19-26

- Christian: One of the most misused and misunderstood names in History
- <u>For several centuries now, this name has meant little more than a European or an American who is not Jewish.</u>
- <u>I think would serve us well to spend our time together</u> this morning defining what a Christian really is.
- It means literally "those of the party of Christ" or even more literally "little Christs" --- meant to be derogatory but was no doubt an honor for the followers of Christ in Antioch.

2. <u>Fairly easy to define a word but what about a person?</u> What constitutes <u>a Christian person?</u>

- There are a number of ways we could come at this:
- 1. Think of it as a label
 - <u>What does a label on a package tell us?</u> Ownership, contents, point of origin, point of destination.
 - <u>Ownership:</u> <u>I Cor. 6:19-20</u>
 - o Contents: Rom. 8:9, Gal. 4:6
 - Point of Origin: Eph. 5:8, Eph. 2:1, Jn. 5:24.
 - Point of Destination: Jn. 14:2-3
 - <u>But this destination is not for everyone who is called</u> or who calls themselves "Christian".
- 2. To be Christian you have to be born one:
 - Only way to get into a human family by blood is to be born into it.
 - Only way to get into the Christian family is by birth. Jn. 3:3
 it involves 2 parents = Spirit of God Jn. 3:5-6 Word of God I Pet. 1:23
- It is a fallacy (it makes no sense) to say, "I'm a born again Christian", that is redundant; because that's the only kind of Christians there are.
- ✓ For a person to say they're a Christian without being born again is a misuse of that term.
- ✓ Your must be born again to be Christian---You can be born once and be an American
- ✓ You must be born twice to be a Christian.
 - 3. This new birth results in a new nature:
 - When you are born to parents with a sinful nature you too have a sinful nature.
 - <u>When you are born to holy parents</u> (Spirit and Word of God) you receive their nature
 - <u>II Pet. 1:4</u>
 - This new nature is what's to blame for this group of followers in
 - Antioch being labeled "little Christ's"
