Acts of Jesus, Lesson 27: God's Purposes

- \rightarrow What will be written on your gravestone?
- \rightarrow What should be written on your gravestone?
- 1. <u>Today, we're going to take look at an epitaph from Scripture that we need to strive to make our own.</u>

<u>Acts 13:36</u>

- His list of failures is probably longer than most, but he still was able to serve God's purposes.
- That should give us a measure of hope!!
- V. 36 == There is not a higher goal is there?
- How's that going to be so for us?
- > <u>It's one thing to mess up</u>, but it's another thing to mess up on purpose.
- > In the context of doing something right, doing it on purpose makes it even better!!
- When all is said and done, I wonder if God will ask us, "Did you do it on purpose?"
 - Did you live your life on purpose?
 - Did you live your life by default or by design?
 - Was it your intent to fulfill My purposes or your own in the brief time you had on earth?
- 2. <u>Probably need to make a distinction here between God serving our purposes and us serving God's purposes.</u>
 - Too many times we get this mixed up; in fact, sometimes God serving our purpose is the motivating factor behind a lot of our spirituality.
 - This spiritual current comes to the surface when God doesn't come through on what we want.
 - > We feel slighted—we feel betrayed "Where is God when I need Him?"
 - We've got it all backwards: God does not exist to serve our purposes; we exist to serve His.
 - > Listen to these verses: Phil. 1:21, Rom. 7:4, II Cor. 5:15
- 3. <u>To serve God's purposes requires a focus shift—it's easy to say, "God I want to serve your purposes", but let's count the cost of having a godly epitaph.</u>
 - 1. A shift in our thinking from just local to global.
 - Acts 1:8 "You will be My witnesses....to the ends of the world."
 - Matt. 28:19a
 - What are you doing to fulfill that mission? Your mission? Actions:
 - 1. Pray for Missions
 - 2. Pay for Missions
 - 3. Go on Missions
 - <u>4.</u> <u>A shift in our thinking from temporal to eternal values</u>.
 - > Two places to check out our values is pocketbook and calendars.
 - > The American dream is not necessarily biblical

Matt. 6:19-20

- 5. <u>A shift in our thinking from security to service.</u>
 - > The ways God leads aren't always logical and safe.
 - God makes plans for our lives based on eternity not time.
- 6. A shift in our thinking from comfort to sacrifice.
 - What would it take to reach the Hesbollah of Lebanon or the Palestinians of the Gaza strip or the <u>Shiite</u> of Afghanistan? The same things that reached a hardened militant pagan world of Paul's day --- the blood of martyrs.
- **<u>V. 36</u>** requires service and sacrifice.
 - -- requires living on purpose.
