## 1. Acts 17:1-6 Do you think these believers chuckled to themselves when they heard this.?

- They lived in a world that was completely upside down.
- Into all that mix Christians brought holiness, purity, love.
- A letter written to a Greek teacher in the middle of the 2<sup>nd</sup> century, the writer marveled at how the Christians, "have their meals in common but not their wives. That they find themselves in the flesh but do not live after the flesh."

## 2. We live in the same world and have the same obligation to help turn right side up.

- Helping our world starts with helping ourselves turn right side up.
- Starts with a reference point: The worst thing you can do when you are following a compass is to interject your feelings.
- North is north and doesn't matter how you feel.
- There are times when you would swear that the compass is broken because it just doesn't feel right.
- Your feelings will get you killed!!
- The same is true in this upside-down world we live in...your feelings will get you in a lot of trouble.
- They have been trained by our fallen nature to desire the very opposite of what we truly need.
- The reference point, like the needle on a compass, is Jesus and His Word.
- Once we are on a way to righting ourselves, Jesus has given us pointers along the way.
- It's not just that we find life by going in the opposite direction, but we need to keep going in the opposite direction to please God.
- The way up is the way down.
