**Luke 9:10-17** Largest quantitative miracle that Jesus performed. The only miracle short of His resurrection that is recorded in all four gospels.

- ✓ This may be the greatest work of creation since creation. He was producing more food out of what? Ex Nihilo "from nothing."
- ✓ But the people were so superficial! Jesus is meeting their temporary needs, so they will listen to His message about their eternal needs.
- 1. Jesus sent the disciples out with supernatural gifting, but only for the sake of human suffering.
  - ✓ This is the realm that Jesus limited Himself to; virtually all of His miracles were an expression of compassion, the compassion of God.
  - $\checkmark~$  Jesus was the full expression of God in human form.
  - $\checkmark$  Never do we see God as clearly as we see Him in the person of Jesus Christ.
  - ✓ When we see Jesus, we see everything that is true about God, great power, great wisdom, great consistency, great sympathy, and compassion for people.
    - 1) Jesus cared that they rested.
    - 2) Jesus cared that the crowd needed healing.
    - 3) Jesus cared that they needed to hear about the kingdom.
    - 4) Jesus cared that they had something to eat.
  - ✓ He was compassionate despite their shallowness. Mathew 14:14, "compassion" here refers to one's gut; in other words, He churned in His gut over these people and their situation.
  - ✓ **Mark 6:34** Great compassion and concern. Human suffering causes God to suffer.

## 2. Why does God Care?

- ✓ Why should God care if you miss a meal? Well, He shouldn't but He does! This is an exceptional testimony to what is called God's common grace.
- ✓ Why should God care if you get what your sins so richly deserve? He shouldn't, but He does.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Peter 3:9; Why does He not just write people off and turn a cold shoulder? Because it's not who He is!
- ✓ Why should it bother Him when people suffer? It shouldn't, but it does!
- $\checkmark~$  He finds the reason to care for us within Himself.
- $\checkmark$  He out of compassion, even though we are rebels, has provided for us.
- ✓ Food is an amazing common grace; it's available to the God haters and the God lovers; not just food but good food, enjoyment in eating it, even satisfaction.
- $\checkmark$  This was a miracle of common grace; He healed out of common grace.
- $\checkmark$  He pitied all of them and had compassion on all of them.
- ✓ He was compassionate despite what He knew; these same people would ask for another sign tomorrow. He would tell them He is the actual bread from Heaven, and they would reject Him.

- ✓ Miracles are divisive occurrences; they either make you better or they make you bitter; they increase your faith or crystalize unbelief. If they don't flip you from unbelief to belief, they harden you and send you over the edge.
- ✓ John gives us the postscript on this event. John 6:26 "not because you saw signs;" signs don't point to themselves, but to something else. Signs that He's the Savior.
- $\checkmark$  John 6:27 "You're missing what the signs point to" your ultimate need.
- ✓ John 6:28-29 "all this food and you will still die; all this healing and you will still perish. Can't you see that there is something more important than your temporary needs?"
