1. Pride and Arrogance repackaged.

- ✓ What used to be called pride and arrogance and got repackaged and resold under a different label - we all bought it.
- ✓ The Bible can't seem to say enough bad about Pride or self-love: Proverbs 16:5; Proverbs 18; Isaiah 2:12, James. 4:6; 10; Jeremiah 9:23-24; 1st John 2:16.
- ✓ Richard Taylor (philosopher) defined pride as "the justified love of oneself", as opposed to false pride or narcissism (although he feels justified in his love of self as well...where do we draw the line?).
- ✓ A narcissist feels justified in his self-love, nonetheless!
- ✓ St. Augustine defined pride as "the love of one's own excellence."
- ✓ Self-esteem is an individual's subjective evaluation of their own worth.
- ✓ **Isaiah 14:12-15**; Satan has certainly proven that self-love is not the answer.
- Satan was deposed and stripped of his glory because he esteemed himself; happens to people as well: **Daniel 5:20.**

2. The Self-Love movement. Purpose of the self-esteem movement was to help people - People who were hopeless and in great need of encouragement and the need to feel loved.

- ✓ It's the same feeling that God has for us and what motivates Him toward us "like sheep without a shepherd" "He remembers that we are but dust."
- ✓ He loves us and has compassion on us and wants to fix us and give us a sense of value and purpose in Him.
- ✓ The self-esteem movement started from good motives, but they arrived at wrong conclusions and solutions.
- ✓ Instead of turning to our Creator, it turned us inward to ourselves: 2nd Corinthians 10:12.
- ✓ In fact, experience and even humanistic research has proven that the self-esteem movement is a farse.
- ✓ Self-esteem or Esteeming Self or Self Love became our mantra to end all crime and fix all our problems but it made things far worse.
- ✓ Self-esteem movement proper start in the 70's and gained momentum in the 80's.
- ✓ Task Force on Self-Esteem and Personal and Social Responsibility in California was started in 1986. - The Study ended by ultimately showing that low self-esteem is not the root of all societal problems and not as important as the committee had originally thought. The task force disbanded in 1995.

3. Traditional view of Self-Esteem.

- ✓ Up until the 20th century, traditional cultures including the biblical culture always believed a high view of self was the root cause of most of the evil in the world.
- ✓ Why do people do bad things? Why are people cruel? Traditionally the answer was pride and arrogance and love of self.
- ✓ The general belief today is that people misbehave for the exact opposite reason lack of selfesteem, self-love.

4. Manic, Depressive culture.

- ✓ Because we based our esteem on self and not God's evaluation, we got an expected result: narcissism and self-hate.
- ✓ Mankind is incapable of balance without God.
- ✓ Instead of returning people to their Creator where they could find that purpose and value, they created a false system of valuation that has led us even further from where our real solution lies.
- ✓ Self-esteem is an individual's subjective evaluation of their own worth.
- ✓ The problem is that we have **no subjective value**, our value will never be found in who we but in Whose we are.
- ✓ Psalms 139:14; We are valuable because God made us!
- ✓ We are valuable because of the price He set on us: I Corinthians 6:20.
- ✓ We only have value in the context of our relationship with God.
- ✓ We only have value because He has assigned value to us, but the valuation is not intrinsic.
- ✓ Mankind only has value in the context of God and belonging to Him. Outside of God we are worthless. In fact, not just worthless - we have a negative value. Isaiah 1:5-6 (way God describes those in rebellion against Him) Ephesians 2:3 "by nature".

✓	Jesus has come to give us value, Jesus died and rose again to give us value: "In Him": Ephesians 1:3; Ephesians 1:4; Ephesians 1:5; Ephesians 1:6-7.
