Acts of Jesus, Lesson 46: A Reason To Suffer

- This week we're going to be looking at a question that is begged by this this entire scene of Paul going to Jerusalem.
- How is that Paul, going in obedience to God to Jerusalem, suffers abuse and imprisonment?
- Do Christian suffer even though they are right in the middle of God's will for their lives?
- Since the answer is yes, then the question is "why do believers suffer even though they are doing God's will?"

Acts 21:8-14

- ✓ Paul goes up to Jerusalem in obedience to the Spirit of God.
- ✓ <u>He then in obedience to the elders and to God helps</u> some Jewish believers perform their vows to God in the Temple.
- ✓ As a result of all this, he is attacked by people who intended to kill him.
- ✓ You may think, "I thought that if you obeyed God, everything would go well for you and you would prosper".
- ✓ You may be unfamiliar with what the Bible tells us in several places II Timothy 3:12, John 16:33b
- ✓ <u>Jesus is the only one who obeyed His Father</u> in everything and look what happened to Him!!!!

Back to our question: "Why do believers suffer even though they are doing God's will?"

- 1. We suffer for the purposes of God. **John 9:2**
 - ✓ We exist to bring God glory in our lives.
 - ✓ Paul's imprisonment brought us the books of **Philippians**,
 - ✓ **Ephesians, I & II Timothy, Titus, Philemon** which bring God glory to this day.
 - √ I Corinthians 6:19-20, Romans 14:7-8
 - ✓ <u>Life is short and if you expend it for just yourself</u>, you have truly wasted it.
- Are you willing to live for the glory of God? That is what you are here for.
- > Are willing to suffer, be lied about, be mistreated if it brings Him glory?
- ➤ How was God glorified in His Son, Jesus? In His death.
- ➤ Jesus says to us, "take up your cross daily and follow Me".

- 2. We suffer so we can see ourselves. James 1:2
 - ✓ Notice: the test is not for God's information but for yours!!!
 - ✓ Tough times have a way of introducing us to ourselves.
 - ✓ We have a lot of faith in God that has never been tried or put to the test.
 - ✓ Trials accomplish that.
 - ✓ The apostle Paul had had many of his beliefs tried, but I can assure you he found out even more about The God he had faith in through_his over 2-year ordeal.
- **Persecution** may reveal whether you prefer the affirmation of God rather than the approval of men.

>	Tough financial times may reveal if you truly believe that God is the one who supplies your needs Illness may reveal whether or not you intend to glorify God not matter what He allows you to go through.
