Acts of Jesus, Lesson 47: A Personal Testimony

Acts 21:27-29 — They figured if Paul would walk down the street with a Gentile that he would take him into the Temple.

Verses 30-38 —

Verses 39-40 – This brings up a special incident in the life and ministry of Paul.

- ✓ Let me show you something: Romans 9:1-3
- ✓ <u>His deep desire was for them, but his ministry ha</u>d been almost exclusively to the Gentiles.
- ✓ <u>He was raised in Tarsus of Cilicia, but his real</u> hometown and hometown crowd was in Jerusalem.
- ✓ This was his only time to ever give his testimony to them!
- \checkmark Therefore, he speaks to them in Aramaic a Hebrew dialect to make sure he catches all ears.
- ✓ <u>He had been their glory boy—the pride of Judaism and</u> of the sect of the Pharisees, but he became a turncoat, in their eyes, and the worst enemy.
- ✓ <u>This is Paul's one and only shot, and he doesn't preach to them</u>, instead he uses one the most powerful tools in the Christian's arsenal to bear witness to Christ <u>his testimony!</u>

Chapter 22:1-21

- ✓ <u>Other religions are philosophies that have their doctrines</u> and teachings, but there is one thing they do not have—changed lives.
- \checkmark <u>Doctrines can be argued</u>, but you can't argue with a changed life.
- ✓ <u>The strongest argument for the Good News about Jesus is someone's life who has been changed by it.</u>
- ✓ That's why Paul doesn't argue theology with these Jews
- ✓ Your most powerful witnessing tool is the story of what Jesus has done for you.
- ✓ When was the last time you told someone that story?

Notice what Paul does here...classic example of a Christian testimony:

- 1. Starts where they are: Hebrew and lost Chapter 22:1-5
 - ✓ Your testimony has the most power with people you are most like and who share your background.
 - \checkmark <u>It is those people who need to hear your testimony the most.</u>
- 2. Tells them of how he accepted Christ. Chapter 22:6-16
- 3. <u>Tells them of what having Jesus in your life has done for you</u>.

Acts of Jesus, Lesson 47: A Personal Testimony

All true testimony is testimony to Jesus Christ, as He stands on trial before the world. Personal testimony eliminates some of the dreaded fears of speaking to someone about Christ:

- \checkmark "<u>I don't know what to say</u>" -- but this is your personal experience...easy of falling off a log.
- ✓ Acts 4:20 "for we cannot stop speaking about what we have seen and heard."
- ✓ "I can't answer the deep theological questions"
- ✓ **John 9:25** "He then answered, "Whether He is a sinner, I do not know; one thing I do know, that though I was blind, now I see."
- ✓ <u>"I can't do it without a lot of training"</u>
- ✓ John 4:28-29 So the woman left her waterpot, and went into the city and said to the men, "Come, see a man who told me all the things that I have done; this is not the Christ, is it?"
