# Acts of Jesus, Lesson 48: The Sovereignty of God

God doesn't just work around circumstances and situations He even works through them

✓ We see this wonderfully illustrated in the life of Paul.

#### Acts 22:21-23

- ✓ <u>It's important to not only have the right friends</u>, but also the right enemies.
- ✓ How would the world react to your stance on the Gospel???

#### Verse 25

✓ <u>Most probably you just simply have a display of</u> Roman heavy handedness...rules of interrogation or steps of getting at the truth were unknown to them—they just jumped to the final step.

**Verses 26-29** – Roman Law explicitly prohibited the binding of Roman citizen without due process.

- ✓ <u>A Roman citizen was not to be beaten under any circumstances</u> even if convicted...the penalty for breaking this law was death!
- ✓ Paul was sort of an upper class Roman citizen having been born such.

### Acts 22:30-23:5 – A couple things to look at here:

- 1. Ananias = someone you need to know
  - ✓ High priest and a Sadducee appointed as High priest by Rome.
  - ✓ According to Josephus, a wicked man
- 2. This makes Paul's apology stand out even more boldly.
  - ✓ Nowhere does the Bible allow us to disrespect authority
  - ✓ All Authority is from God
    - Bad authority God gives as a form of judgment.
    - Good as a form of blessing
    - All authority is from Him.
  - ✓ You can't disrespect authority without in some way disrespecting God.

<u>Acts 23:6-11</u> – <u>So Paul lobs this theological grenade into</u> the group knowing what it would do.

- ✓ From here, he is protected by the Romans both in Jerusalem and Caesarea and is ultimately transported to Rome where he testifies faithfully to the risen Christ.
- ✓ <u>He does all this under great opposition and makes it by the skin of his teeth</u> through a string of incredible coincidences. **Or are coincidences?**

<u>Acts 1:8, 9:15-16</u> (predicted here 30 yrs. before that he would testify before kings and it would come through suffering on his part).

#### Verse 11

### Is this a string of coincidences or is the work of the Sovereign God who knows all things?

- ✓ Paul just happened to be Pharisee.
- ✓ He just happened to have an ancestor who was declared a Roman citizen
- ✓ <u>He just happened to speak Greek</u> that impressed the Roman soldier and Hebrew that impressed the crowd.
- ✓ <u>It just happened that the Jews who were supposed</u> to bear the testimony of the Living God to world in their rejection of God, sent out the church by persecuting it which resulted in it bearing witness to God.
- ✓ <u>It just happened that the pagan empire of Rome footed the bill</u> for the whole thing by protecting one of their citizens and paying his way to Rome, thus guaranteeing that the gospel goes everywhere.

Too	manv	coincidences!

Bottom line is this: People think they do what they want and to some extent they do, but in everything God is still accomplishing His will.

- ✓ Lesson: God is in control.
- but it is safe.

✓ Safest place to be is in the middle of His will: may not make sense, may not be fun, may be hard,
