Bible Prophecy and the book of Revelation, Lesson 24

Chapter 20

- **Verse 1** Battle ends, and beast and false prophet are thrown into Hell.
 - ✓ Next the Devil is chained and thrown into the Abyss (not Hell) a.k.a. Hades.
- Verse 2 How long? 1000years'
 - ✓ <u>Is the Devil bound today?</u> If so, his chain is really too long.!!
- **Verse 3** Millennium (Chapter 20) rather divisive chapter because of its subject matter.

Three camps of belief:

- 1. Premillennialists = Believe in a literal millennium (they take this literally).
- 2. <u>Amillennialist</u> = Don't believe in a literal 1000 year reign of Christ (they take this chapter figuratively)
- 3. <u>Postmillennialist</u> = believe the Millennium has already started with the reign of the church
 - ✓ Church brings it in by reforms (converts everybody)
 - ✓ <u>Kingdom Now theology</u> (also holds that we have replaced Israel and receive her promises including health and wealth)
 - ✓ <u>Fairly easily refuted by the criterion</u> placed on it by the coming Tribulation and especially that of chapter 20.
 - ✓ There are tons of prophecies that have not been fulfilled which could only be fulfilled in the context of a literal thousand year reign.
 - 1. **Isaiah 9:6; Luke 1:32** -- David's throne did not exist at Jesus' first coming, but it is an earthly throne; **Zechariah 14** this follows the same sequence of Revelation -- war which results in the Lord's reign.
 - 2. <u>A multitude of promises to Israel</u> that are yet unfulfilled: <u>Palestinian covenant</u> River of Egypt to the river Euphrates
 - ✓ **Jeremiah 31; Ezekiel 36, 37, 38, 39, 40**; Equals Israel restored to land without a curse or enemy or oppression.
 - ✓ <u>Predicted</u> in <u>Isaiah 2, 4, 11, 12, 30, 35, 60, 61, 66; Jer. 23, 32; Ezekiel 40-48.</u>
 - ✓ Isaiah 11:6-9, Ezekiel 34:20-31, 37:21-28.

Verses 1-2 – If we are currently in the millennium, then is the Devil bound today?

- ✓ **Ephesians 6** "resist the schemes of the Devil"; **I Peter 5:8**
- **Verse 3** <u>Deceiving whole nations!</u>
- <u>Verse 4</u> <u>Thrones = Matthew 19:28</u> = 12 will govern Israel...who will govern the rest of the planet...we will!! <u>Revelation 2:26-27</u>
 - ✓ <u>Ironically, the Beast and false prophet</u> sought to rule the world and put to death those who would not receive their mark, but who is reigning now?!!

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- <u>Verse 5</u> <u>Who makes it into the first resurrection</u>? Jesus = First fruits of harvest to come; All who believe prior to Christ; All the church; and all who believe during the Tribulation.
- **Verse 6** How long? 1000 thousand years over this current earth!
 - ✓ <u>All literal things here</u>: Jesus is, thrones are, martyrs are, Devil is, 1000 years are!!
 - ✓ "Second Death" -- born once= die twice; born twice= die once (Jesus has taken our second death for all who trust Him)
- **Verse 7** Why turn the Devil loose? Tell me why the first time and I'll tell you why the second time!
 - ✓ <u>Devil is the result of choices (His and ours) and consequences</u> of rebellion.
- **Verses 8-9** "Beloved City"? Jerusalem
 - ✓ <u>Conditions are similar that prior to the flood</u> with one added bonus = no Devil!
 - ✓ People are living much longer (**Isaiah 65:19-25**); there is an ideal government.
 - ✓ Even a 1000 years of ideal conditions will not cure a sinful heart.

- **Verse 10** The third resident enters Hell
- **Verse 11** What a blow for the ecologists.
 - ✓ So, the earth can't be saved? **Isaiah 65:17**

<u>Judgment is never God's first or preferred option if it were, none of us would be here.</u>

- ✓ "Not willing that any should perish, but all come to repentance", but there will come a day when Grace expires.
- **✓ Revelation 20:11-15**
- ✓ How long will God hold His hands to people who hate Him and malign His name?
- ✓ <u>How long will He hold back wrath upon</u> those who trample underfoot His offering of peace through the sacrifice of His One and Only Son?? **Not forever One day grace will expire!**
- ✓ <u>A day is coming when every wrong will be exposed</u> and every sin will be paid for: either by Christ, or the person who committed the sin.

<u>Everybody thinks it won't happen to them!</u> The Atheist is hoping God doesn't exist, the Hindu hopes he just gets reincarnated, most just feel that they haven't been all that bad.
