<u>Verses 7-9</u> – <u>Nearly perfect environment for 1000 years, no Devil</u>, and yet there still is rebellion against the Son of God.

A perfect environment cannot produce a perfect heart

Verse 10 – Third resident of Hell.

• <u>Notice carefully that the Beast and False Prophet are still there</u> after a thousand years and still exist and are still being tormented.

Verse 11

The earth cannot and will not be saved.

Verse 12 – John 5:26-29, John 6:29

• Who are these dead? We already know that they are not saved because all the saved have been resurrected in the first resurrection

Verses 4-6

- Why does God go through motions of judgment when they are essentially are already judged??
- He saves instantaneously but He judges very slowly and methodically
- Notice: one book of life and many books of deeds, book of life only contains names!!
- Notice: Judge but no jury; prosecution but no defense; sentencing but no appeal -- This is not a trial but a sentencing procedure.

<u>Verses 13-14a</u> – <u>Death dies right here as does the place of the dead</u> (Hades) because no one will be dying ever again.

Hell is the permanent abode of all who refuse Christ.

Verses 14-15 –Now Hell will be occupied for ever more.

Remember Hell isn't "down there" Hell is out there:: Matthew 8:11-12; Matthew 22:11-14;
Isaiah 66:22-24

Chapter 21

Moving from time to eternity now and from old to new creation.

Verse 1 -The O.T. has long since said this: Isaiah 65:17, Isaiah 66:22, 2 Peter 3:13

Verse 2 – The city isn't the bride, but the Bride will be there

- Where is this city coming from?
- Where is it going? Why? Because God will not be thwarted of His plans for man to dwell eternally on the earth!

Verse 3 – This is the way it was in the Garden of Eden.

Verse 4 – How prominent are these things today?

- You realize that the entire earth is a graveyard from the flood of Noah?
- This will no longer be so!!

<u>Verses 6-7</u> – Who is the overcomer? <u>1 John 5:1-5</u>				
Verse 8 – This is what we all are, but in Christ we are declared righteous.

<u>Verses 12-14</u> – <u>Notice the mixture of Jewish and Christian</u> here because all will who had faith in God				
will be there and there will be no more separation.				
<u>Verses 15-16</u> – <u>These are dimensions that defy current physics</u> (1,500 miles high!?)				
 Just to give you an idea of how big that is: 				
■ This city (a cube) will be 3,375,000,000 cubic miles in volume = 16,875,000,000,000 cubic feet				
→which could accommodate 625,000,000 rooms at 27,000,000 cubic feet per room or floor space of 90,000 square feet.				
Verse 17 – Of course this wall is symbolic because there will be nothing to protect from anymore. Gates				
are never closed.				
<u>Verses 18-20</u> –				
<u>Verse 21</u> – <u>notice not "streets"</u> but "street" to be sure.				
<u>Verses 22-27</u> – <u>Much better than the Garden of Eden</u> because Satan will never be there nor will sin.
