John 15:1-5, 8

- In pruning, we are not cutting away a cancerous growth, but taking away otherwise healthy growth making room for intended growth.
 - ♥ In a vineyard, a vinedresser Prunes for 4 specific reasons:
 - 1) to remove what is dead or dying,
 - 2) to make sure sunlight can get to all branches,
 - 3) to increase size and quality of the fruit,
 - 4) to encourage new fruit to develop.

Why does a vinedresser prune? "Because if the vine is not pruned it reverts very quickly to its wild nature."

- 1) Climbing everywhere making a long, sinewy trunk
- 2) Resulting in small, scraggly bunches of uneven grapes.
- ✓ Is this you? All over the place, untrained, unfruitful.
- ✓ Vines last a very long time, but branches have a very short lifespan.
- ✓ Branches basically have one season to produce and then it's over, they die back and are removed to make way for new branches in the next season.
- ✓ Likewise, we just have one life, no time to just ramble all over the place, grow in any direction we want or would like.
- ✓ Are you certain you are where God wants you to be? Are you certain you are doing what God wants you to do?
- ✓ Our Father, the ultimate Vinedresser, is guided certain principles: To make room for the kind of abundance He created us for, He will cut away parts of our lives that drain precious time and energy from what's truly important.

You have been commissioned by your Lord to manage a single asset of His: YOUR LIFE

- ✓ Your Life: The sum of your talents, strengths, personality, opportunity, and material possessions.
- ✓ Your Lord will return, and you will give an account for how you spent His asset
- ✓ Therefore, every day you should be asking yourself this question: "How will I manage what My Lord has placed into my care?"
- ✓ In fact, every day you are answering that guestion!!!
- ✓ One Goal for our lives = bearing fruit
- ✓ One Purpose = Bringing glory to God, Verse 8
- ✓ One Way = Verse 5.
- ✓ One goal, purpose, and way for our lives, but our world pushes us into fragmented and misdirected directions.

Luke 9: If You Want to Follow Jesus, Part 8

- ✓ Resulting in little effort or energy put towards fruit bearing.
- ✓ When we cry out to God to help us live a life that matters, He prunes us removing those preoccupations and priorities that keep us from a more significant ministry for Him.
- ⇔ We've got choices to make:
 - 1) Trust our eternity to the only one who can bring us to God.
 - 2) Make fruit bearing the goal of our lives.
 - 3) Allow God to make room in our lives for more and more fruit.
