## Luke 9: The Prideful Look, Part 3

#### Luke 9:46-50

- ✓ Mankind's fall from glory came as a result of pride: **Genesis 3:5** "we can have God-like status!"
- ✓ "One of the biggest differences between you and God is that God never
- ✓ thinks He's you."
- ✓ Matthew 18:3, Our actual status is that of children.
- ✓ Children bring no intrinsic value with them.
- ✓ Children aren't assets they are liabilities, so why do we love them? Because they are ours!
- ✓ Children aren't supposed to have anything to offer! That's the Parent's job.
- ✓ We have nothing to offer God, instead, God has everything to offer us.
- ✓ Take the status of child so that God can fully take the status of you Father!

#### 1. What is Humility?

#### Humility if Reality

- ✓ Humility is living in truth about ourselves: We aren't God; our status forever is that of children.
- √ Romans 12:3

# Humility is dependency

✓ Instead of believing the lie: "You'll be like God", start every day acknowledging our dependance on Him, our need of Him, our confidence in Him alone. That's humility.

#### Humility is conviction of sin

- ✓ Matthew 5:3-4 poverty (cringing beggar) and mourning Luke 18:13.
- ✓ Measure your humility by your sense of unworthiness of God's forgiveness and grace.
- ✓ Take the status of a cringing beggar, a vulnerable, needy person so that God can take the status of being of the supplier of all your needs!
- ✓ Measure your humility by your willingness to forgive others.

### Humility is ceasing to think about yourself

- ✓ High self-esteem is prideful and is thinking about oneself constantly and vainly.
- ✓ Low self-esteem is thinking a lot of yourself as well, constantly on feelings of inferiority, not measuring up, etc.
- ✓ Humility is neither high nor low self-esteem; humility is ceasing thinking of yourself altogether.

# Measure your humility by your willingness for others to receive the prominence and credit while you are forgotten.

- Humility is being like God
  - ✓ Philippians 2:5-6, Jesus had no pride or self-esteem, nothing to prove, thought nothing of Himself only of us, be like Jesus!
  - ✓ Jesus was God telling us, in person, who HE is.
  - ✓ What did He tell us? "the Lamb of God", no creature more Humble.
  - ✓ At His baptism where John the Baptist called Him the Lamb of God, the Holy Spirit descended in the form of dove; two of the most humble creatures on the planet.
  - ✓ HE could have been born anywhere, at any time, to anyone, but He was born in a tiny town, in a stable, laid in a manger, acknowledged by a handful of shepherds.
  - ✓ HE could have grown up anywhere and done anything, but He was the son of manual laborer and lived in a town that had nothing and was on the way to nothing and meant nothing to the people of that day.
  - ✓ He could have lived any way He wanted but He tells a follower "the Son of Man has nowhere to lay His head."
  - ✓ At His death they divided all He had, and it turned out just to be the clothes on His back.
  - ✓ They crucified Him stark naked—tell me He wasn't humble!

Measure your humility by your hunger to see Jesus receive all the glory in your life.
