Luke 9:46-50

- ✓ Last time saw that humility is reality, its who we are, its child status so God can be in the Father status, it's a cringing beggar so that God can be our total supply.
- ✓ Matthew 5:3-4, Jesus is making a prescription for a happy life, "happy are those who...", prescription of poverty of spirit, vulnerability, neediness, dependency.
- ✓ You can either be strong in yourself, self-sufficient, self-supplied, prideful, and arrogant, or you can be strong in Him, but you can't be both.
- ✓ You'll either be broken in one or you will be broken in the other.
- ✓ God's prescription is that we be broken in ourselves.

1. A man who needed breaking: Genesis 32:23-24, 25

- ✓ He wrestled with God. It's made clear in several places, but you can hear it in what he names the place. Verse 30.
- ✓ He wrestled with God and won! **Verse 28**
- ✓ Have you never wrestled God? Over a decision? Over a direction? Over obedience? and won?
- ✓ Our wrestling and winning is our main problem as opposed to surrendering, submission, dependency, and brokenness.
- ✓ Our problem is that we keep winning! It's time that we lose!
- ✓ Did Jacob actually win? God could have crushed him, but instead he just broke him so that He could be useful.
- ✓ God could just crush us, but he chooses to break us so that we can be useful to him.
- ✓ He left permanently broken Verses 31-32.
- ✓ God had to break him to change his character.
- ✓ God has got to break us to change us, He's got to break our terrible habits of self-reliance, and self-focus, our pride and arrogance.
- ✓ Jacob has to limp to become Israel!
- ✓ It is why this is true for us: **Psalms 51:17**. How very important brokenness is!

2. A second man who needed breaking: 2 Corinthians 12:5-7

- ✓ Another broken man, the problem is still pride, but there is something different about his circumstances.
- ✓ Jacob was already a prideful cheat, Paul wasn't!
- ✓ To keep Paul humble, God allowed this trouble in his life.
- ✓ Its super hard to give greatness to sinners because they will take credit for it.
- ✓ "That the power of Christ might rest on me" sometimes it can't rest on us because we would take credit for it.
- ✓ Can you be trusted with His glory?
- ✓ God had a great asset in the apostle Paul and had invested even more in him, but in order to hedge His investment, He allowed this trouble.

Luke 9: The Prideful Look, Part 4

✓ It was given to Him to "Buffet" him, a word used for a blow with a clenched fist, a body blow.
✓ Hear what Paul is saying: "I'm so much better for it."
✓ Have you got anything in your life that gives you a body blow?
✓ Allow it to do what God has allowed it for, to break you of your pride, self-reliance and bring you to a place of humility and God-reliance.
