## Bible Prophecy and the book of Revelation, Lesson 11

## **Chapter 6**

**Chapters 4 & 5** are a prelude and introduction...we have in view the command center of the universe as depicted in those chapters, and from the that command center the King begins to reign...

- <u>He's bought all with His blood and now has to remove the usurpers</u> from His property and the false prince to whom it all has been given until now that Jesus challenges his ownership.
- This precipitates the event of **Chapter 6-19.**

Recognize the disparity between what mankind says about the future and what God says: People say it's getting better, God says it is going to get <u>far</u> worse.

- 1. "Everything is getting better" We are confusing technological advances with moral and social advances.
  - We have the technology to know and provide for the needs of mankind unlike we ever have before, but we still aren't doing it.
  - What have we done with our technology? We killed more people in wars of this past century than in all other centuries combined!!
- 2. <u>"Conquering disease"</u> But we haven't! We have only kept them at bay and now people aren't getting vaccinated like they were. Add to that an ever-increasing upward mobility and we are set for plagues again.

<u>Background for this section</u>: (besides the entire Bible!) <u>Luke 4:16-19</u> (pay attention the period at the end of <u>Verse 19</u>) - Jesus closes the book ahead of <u>Verses 20-21</u>

- <u>Isaiah 61:1-2a</u> (here Jesus strategically closes the book because that was what He came the first time to do)
- Verse 2b The comma at the end of V. 2 represents now a 2,000-year interval.

Review of **Dan 9: 24-27** 

## **Chapter 6**

**Verse 1** - "Come" = "proceed" – something or someone is being released or allowed to come forth.

**Verse 2** - Is this Jesus? == Jesus does come on a white horse with crowns in **Revelation 19:11-13** 

- Here there is only one crown, and it is a stephanos (Greek) a victor's crown. Whereas in Ch. 19 there are many crowns on Jesus, and they are diademata or ruling crowns.
- Alos this one is riding with 3 partners: War, Famine, Death.
- "Bow" -- **Bow but no arrows**.
- The Bow could be used for war, but it is also a symbol of peace especially when there are no arrows (e.g. Rainbow)
- <u>In fact, the word for bow and covenant</u> in the Hebrew are almost identical.
- How does the Antichrist begin his relationship with Israel?? Covenant!! **Dan. 9:27**
- The Antichrist is a card that the Devil has wanted and, in fact, tried to play several times throughout history (many Roman Emperors, Hitler, etc.), but God has not allowed it.

<ul> <li>There is coming a day in which what is blocking this will be taken out of the way II         Thessalonians 2:1-12.     </li> <li>"Conquering and to conquer" but with peace! With a bow with no arrows!</li> </ul>
<u>Verse 3</u> – <u>What follows is in accord with who the</u> Antichrist is: Red is associated with terror and death (elsewhere in Revelation red dragon, red beast, Red Prostitute)
<ul> <li>Verse 4 –</li> <li>Verse 5 - Black is associated with famine</li> <li>Verse 6 - Implies rationing of the staples, but oil and wine were luxuries; seems to imply that the average man will be in dire straits while the powerful and wealthy will be even more in luxury.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Verses 7-8 - "Hades" not "Hell" = the holding place of the wicked dead</li> <li>Death claims the body and Hades claims the soul.</li> <li>Sword, Famine, Pestilence == these make sense, but what about "Wild Beasts"? Does it have lions and bears and snakes?</li> <li>Remember that 75% of Europe was wiped out by rats and fleas carrying the bubonic plague.</li> <li>Matthew 24:4-8 - (Notice, we have the exact same order as Rev. 6) This is just the beginning!!</li> <li>One prerequisite for Jesus 2<sup>nd</sup> coming, do you know what it is? Hosea 5:15 - Israel is in the spotlight now.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Verses 9-10 – Interesting place to find these that were killed "underneath the altar" the place in the O.T. where the blood of the sacrifices was poured.</li> <li>They are "souls" and have no bodies. Why? The resurrection has not taken place for them which tells us when they died. When???</li> <li>Gen. 4:9-10Heb. 12:24 What must God hear??</li> <li>"Earth dwellers" a classification of people that we will come across quite often in Revelation</li> <li>Earth dwellers is a designation for people whose citizenship is only on earth and not in Heaven.</li> <li>"Lord" here is unusualtypically the word Kurios is used, but here it is Despotais (despot) – Greeks reserved this word for one who invades and takes possession.</li> <li>Verse 11 – More are coming!</li> <li>Verses 12-17 – bumper sticker "Beware of the Lamb"—can you imagine??</li> </ul>
