"I am reminded of your sincere faith, which first lived in your grandmother Lois and in your mother Eunice and, I am persuaded, now lives in you also", 2 Timothy 1:5.
- ✓ The Church in My Life. Church Was There for Me. My Life in the Church is "I am there for others." Be Steady in Your Confession of Hope.
- ✓ Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful. Hebrews 10:23. And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, Hebrews 10:24. Not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near, Hebrews 10:25.
